### **Breeding Contract Information:**

- 1. Enclosed is your Breeding Contract. If you are choosing to breed via Shipped Cooled Semen, please enter the information as required on the Breeding Contract. DeGraff Stables is not offering mare reproductive services on farm, however, we will perform a "Haul-In Inseminations On-Farm". We will be happy to coordinate the insemination around our standard collection dates for the stallion you have chosen for the breeding season.
- 2. Enclose your Non-Refundable Booking Fee With the Stallion's Breeding and Shipping Contract(s)
- 3. Enclose a Copy of your Mare's Papers (front & back)

Once the STALLION OWNER and STALLION MANAGER have accepted and executed the Breeding Contract, your Original Copy will be signed and a copy returned to you. We will also send you:

- 1. A form that will identify for you the Payment of the Balance of the Fee schedule
- 2. Contact Information and Procedures for Ordering Shipped Cooled Semen/Haul-In or Contact

#### At the time that the MARE OWNER is shipped cooled semen:

- 1. Completed Breeding Contract and Shipped Semen Information Must be on File
- 2. Provide copy of a Negative Uterine Culture, Satisfactory Equine Cytology with Sensitivity for all mares that are Open/Barren. These tests results should be current within 30 Days.
- 3. Breeding Fee Must be paid in full to stallion owner. MC/Visa Accepted
- 4. Shipped Semen Fee(s) as apply Must be paid in full, or MC/Visa on file for charges.

# At the time that the mare is delivered to DeGraff Stables for Haul-In breeding, the following must accompany the mare Mares Bred at Farm ~ Please Arrange Insemination 1 Week in advance:

- 1. Stallion Breeding Fee Must be paid in full to Stallion owner. <u>PLEASE NOTE... Of necessity, we need your cooperation to Haul-In mare(s) during daytime hours Monday-Saturday!</u> We apologize, after business hours cannot be accommodated.
- 2. Provide copy of Current Negative Coggins Test and Current Health Certificate
- 3. Provide copy of a Negative Uterine Culture, Satisfactory Equine Cytology with Sensitivity for all mares that are Open/Barren; current within 30 Days.
- 4. Provide a Current Veterinarian's State Health Certificate

5. At the time that the mare is released from DeGraff Stables's premises, all fees and expenses must be paid in full. Check, Money Order or Master Card/Visa are Accepted (a 4% Bank Fee will apply for credit card charges) – pay to DeGraff Stables, Inc.
